Bal Adhikar Pariyogna, Child Reporter's Programme and Childline focuses on Rights of the children i.e. Survival&Development, Protection and participation .Through Every person has right to adequate housing and Samaveshi Sheher, we reach to intervention slums of Jharkhand for security tenure and basic civic amenities. Improving social and economic empowerment of women by changing nutritional status, health and hygiene practices of women and children, thereby linking women to livelihood and formation of SHG. Crèche (Palna Ghar) is being run by ASES with the support from local donors. In order to protect the environment, garbage of the slums are collected by ASES and dumped at place used for Solid Waste Management. This enhances the living and health condition of the slums. Adarsh Seva Sansthan (ASES) came into existence in 1987 in Jamshedpur's brick kiln areas for ensuring education of children. Brick kiln settlements were established by migrant workers on the banks of the river 'Swarnrekha' and 'Kharkai'.ASES started operation for the development of slum children as most of the children were malnourished, suffer health problem due to environmental changes and didn't attend school. Adarsh Seva Sansthan (ASES) is an autonomous and independent non-sectarian, non-political, nonprofitable, non-government and humanitarian social society or unit under Societies Registration Act XXI, 1860 in 1991 with clear-cut socio-economic objectives for the development of the people, by the people and for the people. ADARSH SEVA SANSTHAN literally means the Institution or Society or organization of people or group which provides ideally perfect kind of services with right based approach for qualitative change among and within the underprivileged, needy marginalized, exploited and vulnerable poor sections of the society.
